Demographic and Wage Data Report

This data is accurate as of August 2023 and only represents members of the workforce who participate in MiRegistry.

Introduction

MiRegistry proudly supports members of the Michigan Early Childhood and Out of School Time workforce by providing a statewide data system for professionals, trainers, and organizations to verify and track employment and training and educational accomplishments. In addition to providing direct customer service, MiRegistry serves as a data clearinghouse, with the responsibility of providing a database to store user information, collecting and verifying accurate data, and reporting out on data to assist policymakers in developing resources, spearheading initiatives, and making decisions that directly impact the workforce.

As the world works to find its new “normal” following the global Covid-19 pandemic, many industries are contending with perceived difficulties retaining quality staff. The Early Childhood and Out of School Time industry continues to be affected by this upheaval. The purpose of this report is to provide wage and other employee data housed within the MiRegistry system data to draw attention to areas in which positive change can be made for this critical industry.

Note, the data in this report does not represent the entire Early Childhood and Out of School Time workforce for the State of Michigan because participation in MiRegistry is voluntary. Only those who participate in MiRegistry are represented in this report.

Because there is a comprehensive list of all licensed programs in the State of Michigan, investigators were able to determine that 67% of all licensed programs had at least one employee’s data included in the data sample. In total, the data sample includes data for individuals employed at 5,262 licensed programs. At the time of this report, there were a total of 7,896 licensed child care programs operating in the State of Michigan.

It is also important to note – the size of the workforce is unknown. We do not have a comprehensive list of all child care providers employed in licensed programs, making it difficult to determine the percent of individual members of the workforce represented in this report.

Additionally, as we continue to support gathering information on this very important workforce, MiRegistry is currently in the process of updating the position title options for center, family, and group home providers to support increased clarity in choice and data reporting on position titles.

Research Questions and Methods

Research Areas

Research was conducted in the following key areas:

1. General Demographics including:
 - a. Ethnicity
 - b. Age
 - c. Gender
 - d. Education level
 - e. Setting
2. Wage Distribution
 - a. By Education Level
 - b. By Position Title
 - c. By Demographic Data

Data Sampling Procedures

- All data was pulled in August 2023
- All participants have the following characteristics:
 - Verified employment (by the program) at a licensed program.
 - All licensed programs:
 - Are in a Center, Group, or Family Home child care setting
 - Have either a license with an Active or Suspended, but not Closed Status
 - Participants self-selected one of the following position titles based on which one best represents their work:
 - Assistant Teacher/Family Child Care Assistant
 - Lead Caregiver/Teacher
 - Assistant Director
 - Administrator/Program Director/School-age Site Supervisor
 - Owner/Operator
- Educational attainment data:
 - Has been verified by MiRegistry.
 - Has been narrowed to the following types:
 - CDA (Unexpired)
 - Some College
 - College Certificate
 - Associate Degree
 - Bachelor's Degree
 - Master's Degree
 - Doctorate Degree

Data Sampling Procedures Contd.

- Wage data:
 - Annual Salary data was converted to Hourly Wage data using hours per week and months per year as reported.
 - Wage outliers (data reported at under \$7.50/hour and over \$250/hour) were removed.
 - All wage data has been verified by the program.
- “Duplicate” Records
 - In cases when a participant may have more than one current employment record attached to their MiRegistry profile, all current positions were included to ensure data has been captured for each unique role within a given program.
 - In cases when a participant may have more than one verified education record attached to their MiRegistry profile, only the highest level of attainment was included.

Sample Description

Four data samples were pulled to generate this report:

1. General Demographic Data
 - a. This data sample includes all participants, including those who did not choose to share wage data or whose wage data fell into the outlier categories.
 - b. The total number of participants within this data set is 35,176.
2. General Wage Data
 - a. This data sample includes all participants who also have verified employment data and whose wage data did not fall into outlier categories.
 - b. The total number of participants within this data set is 16,668.
3. General Education Data
 - a. This data sample includes all participants who have verified education records on their MiRegistry profiles.
 - b. The total number of participants within this data set is 8,452.
4. Wage Data Limited to Participants with Verified Education Records
 - a. This data sample includes all participants who also have verified employment data and whose wage data did not fall into outlier categories and who have verified education records on their MiRegistry profiles.
 - b. The total number of participants within this data set is 3,903.

In cases when investigators felt additional steps should be taken in order to protect the identities of respondents, response groups with at least one, but fewer than ten respondents have their response counts removed from tables and replaced by “-” in the response count column. In cases where removing the response counts for only the categories with fewer than ten respondents would remove too small of a response pool to protect identities (e.g. the only two categories with fewer than ten respondents represent a total pool of two respondents), the response count of the category with the next smallest response count was also removed.

Figure 1: Ethnicity

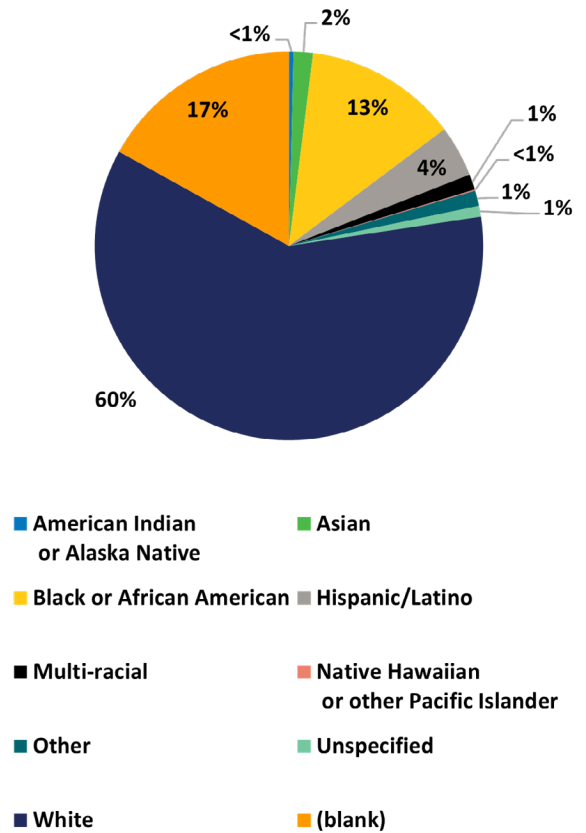

Figure 2: Gender

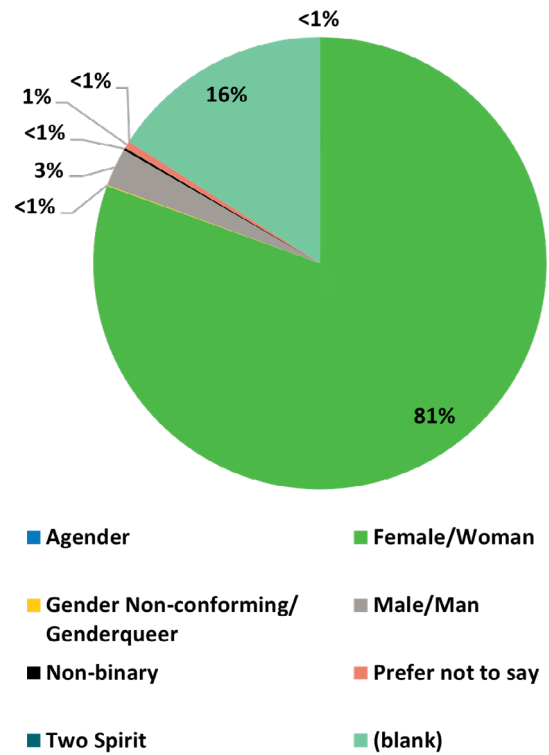

Figure 3: Age

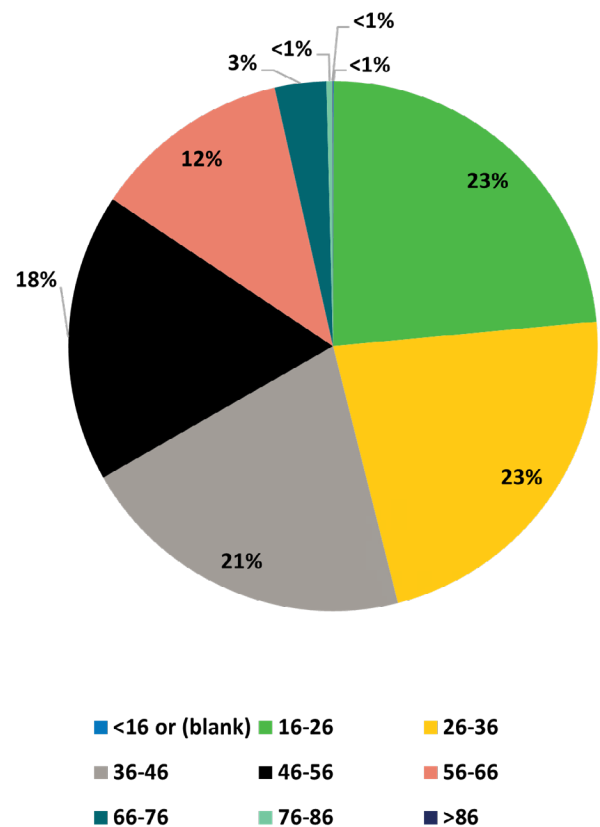

Figure 4: Primary Language

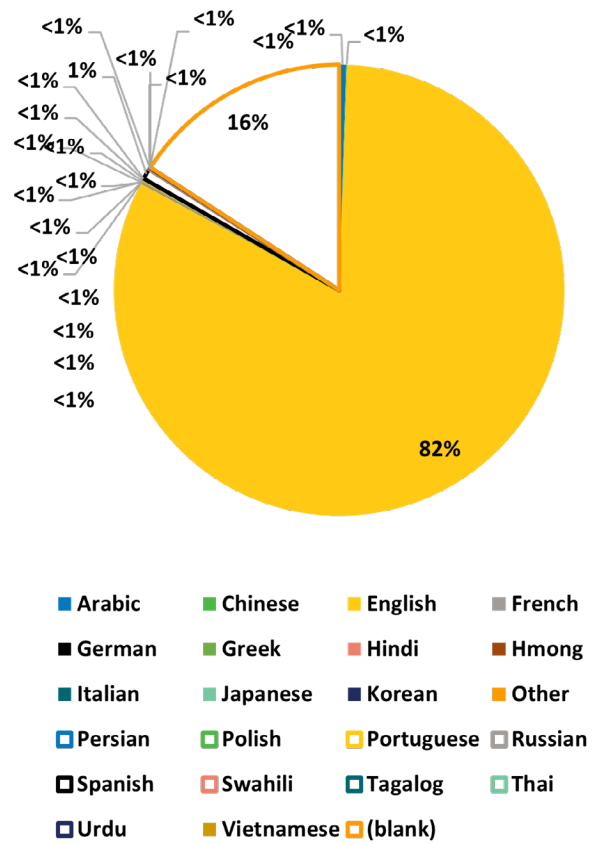

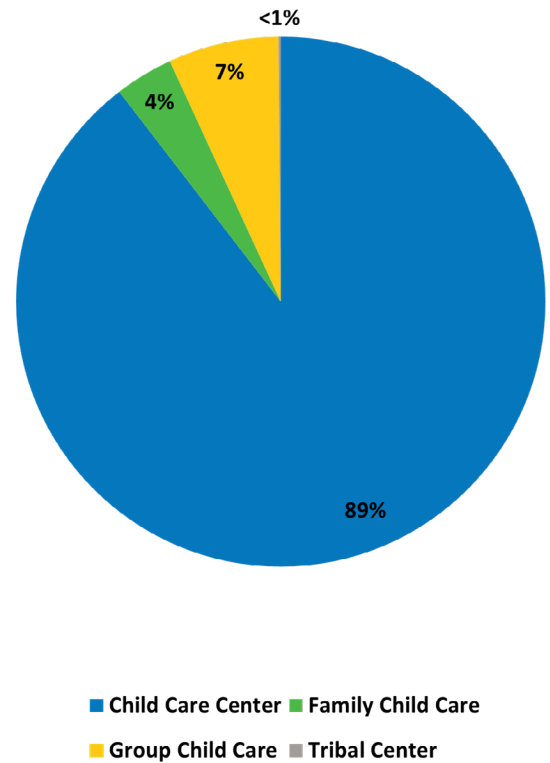

Figure 6: Position Title

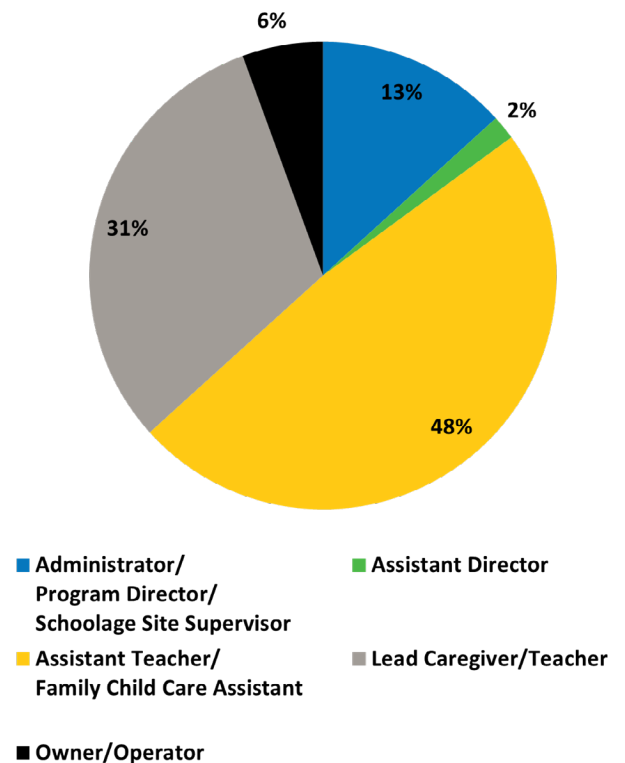

Figure 7: Position Title by Setting

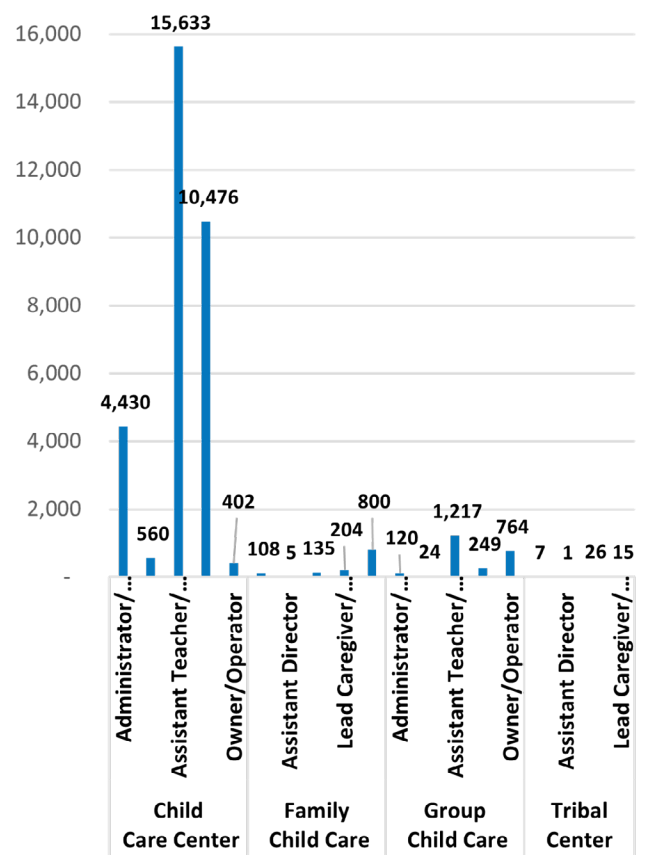

Figure 8: Average Tenure by Position Title

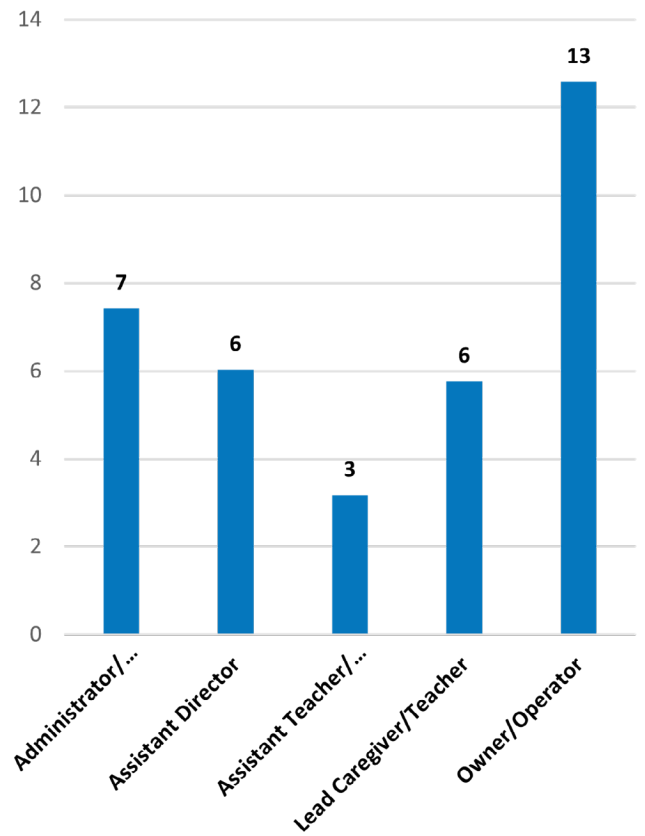
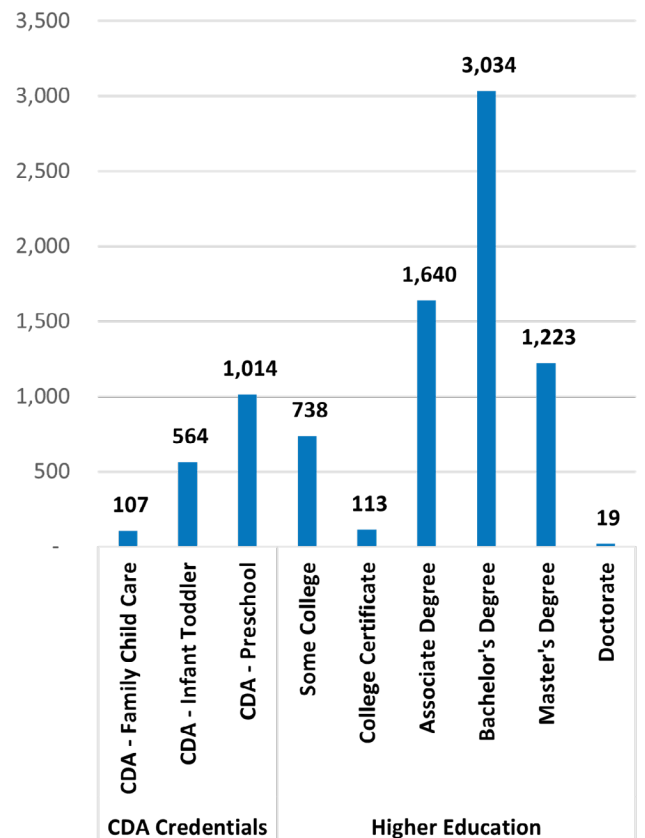

The average hourly wage for those who have verified employment data and whose wage data did not fall into outlier categories (16,668) is \$16.07.

The average hourly wage for those who have verified employment data and whose wage data did not fall into outlier categories and also have verified education records on their MiRegistry profiles (3,903) is \$19.37

Figure 10: Verified Wage Distribution by Ethnicity

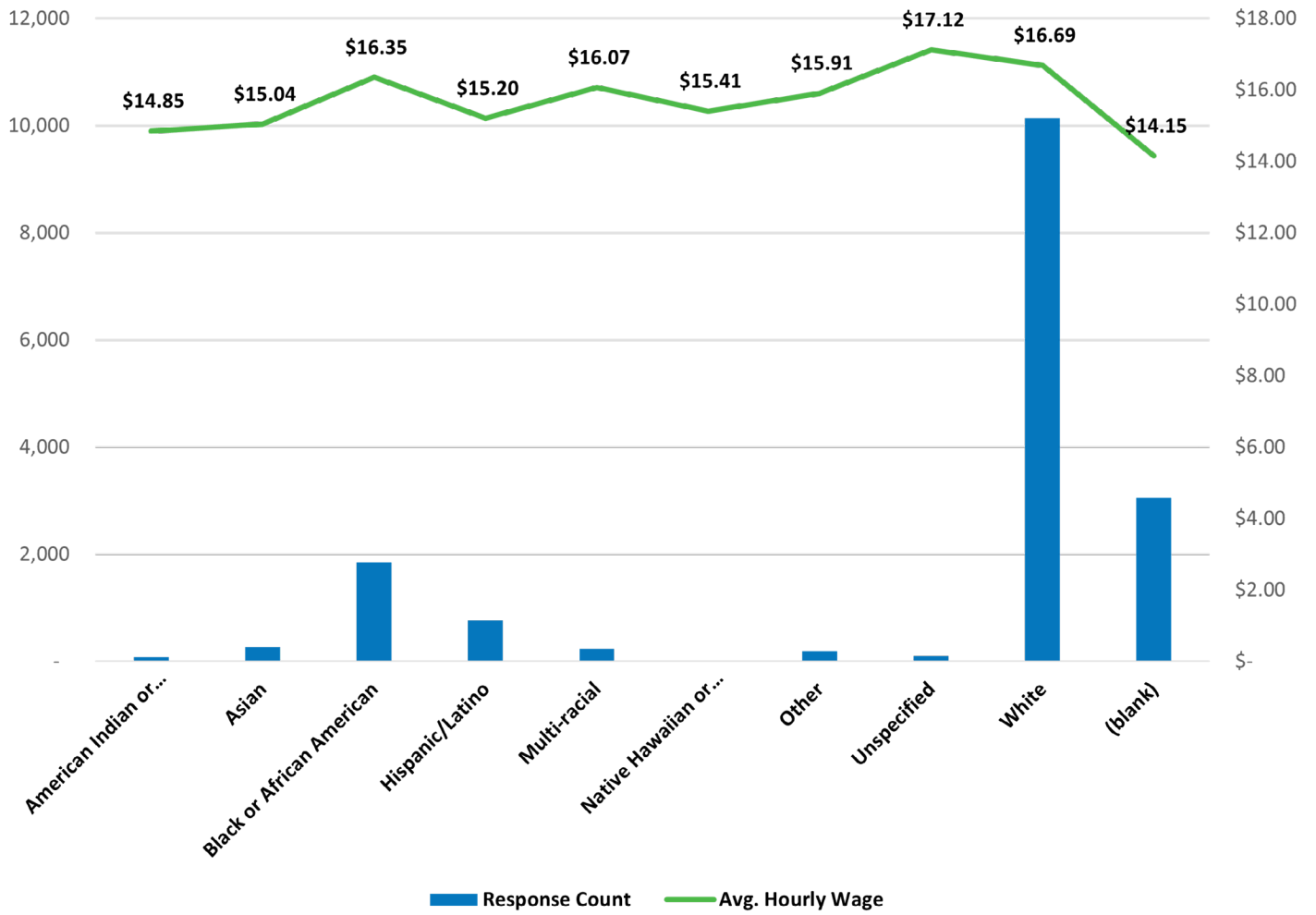

Figure 11: Verified Wage Distribution by Gender

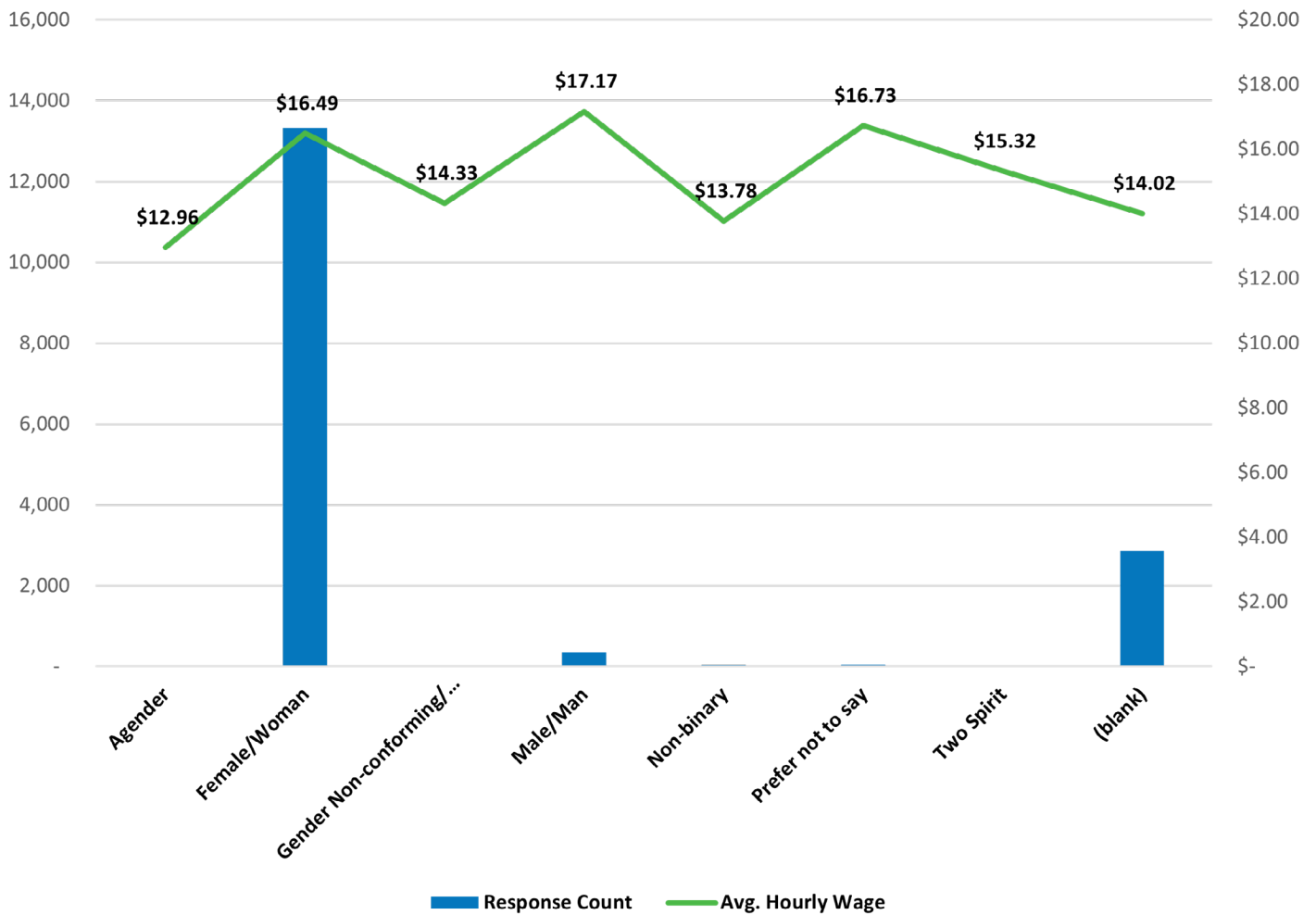

Figure 12: Verified Wage Distribution by Age

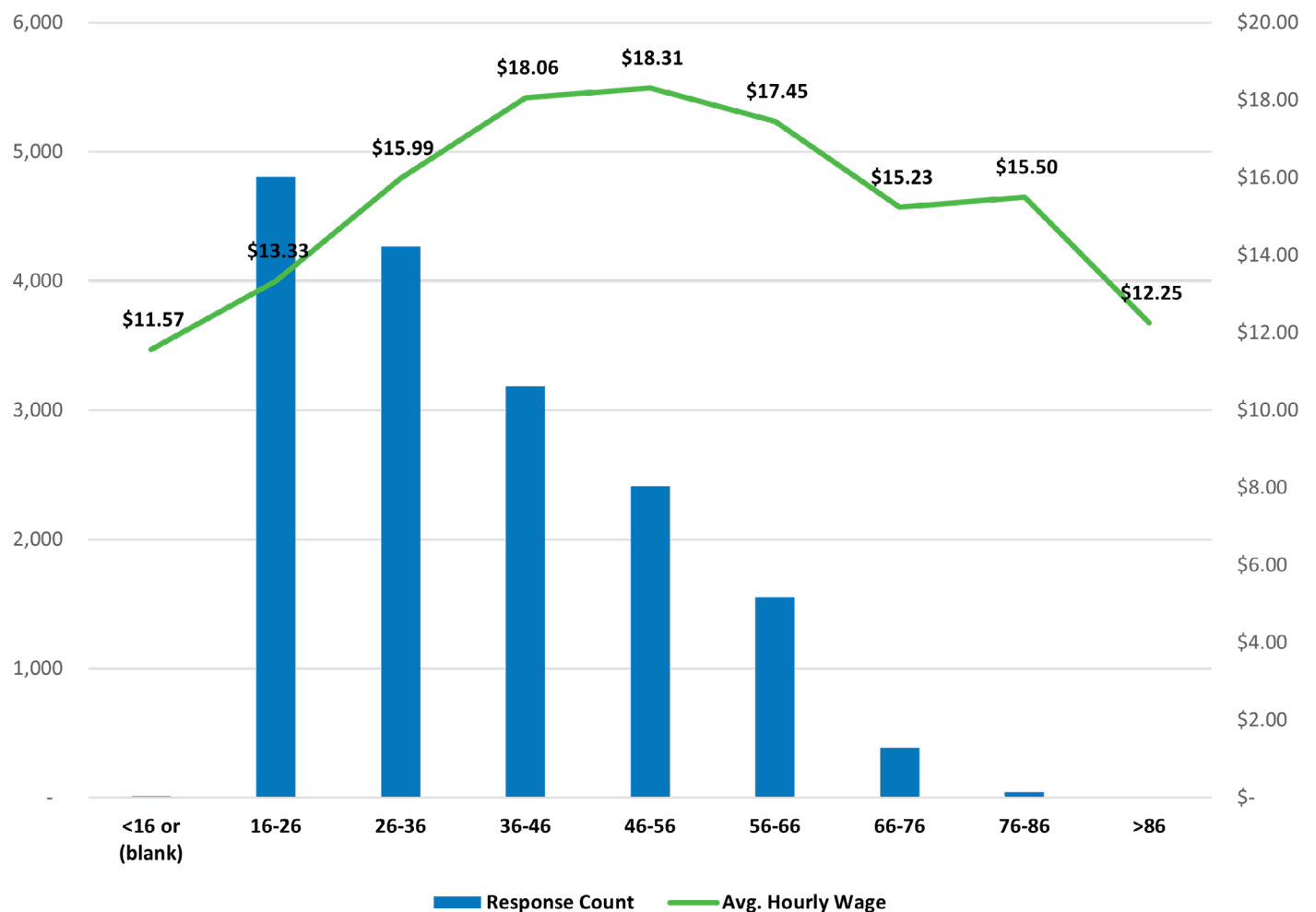

Figure 13: Verified Wage Distribution by Language

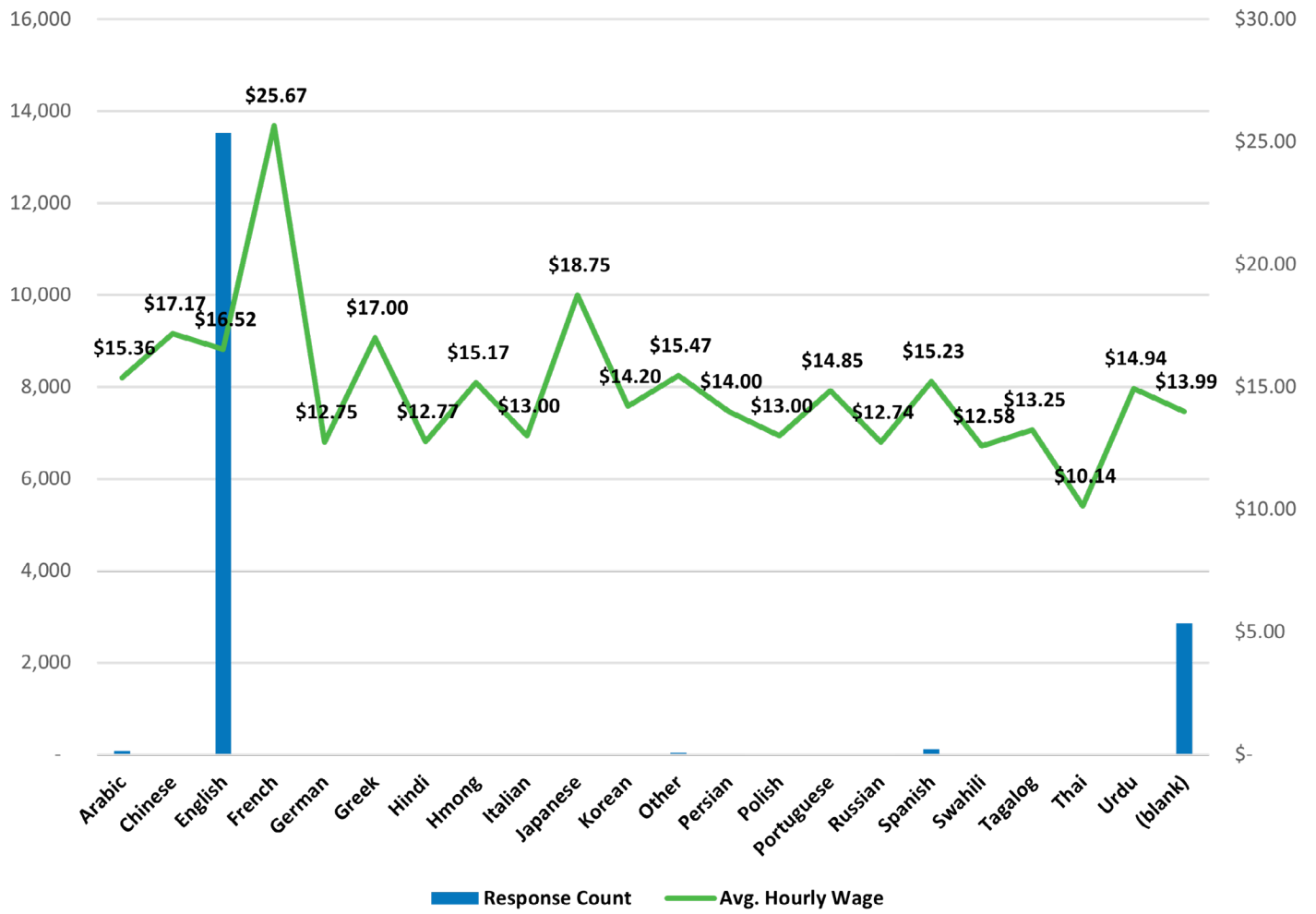

Figure 14: Verified Wage Distribution by Setting

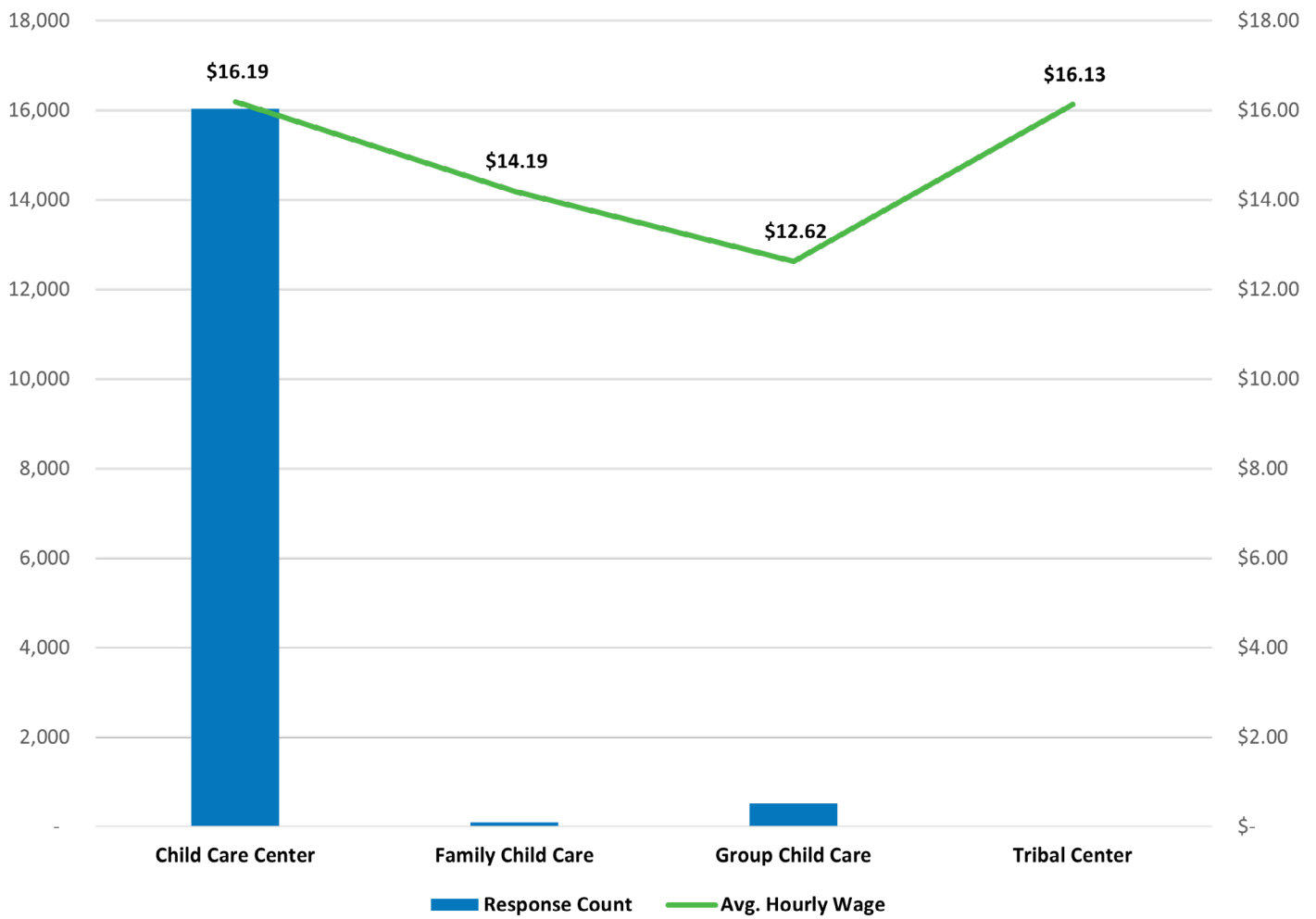

Figure 15: Verified Wage Distribution by Position Title

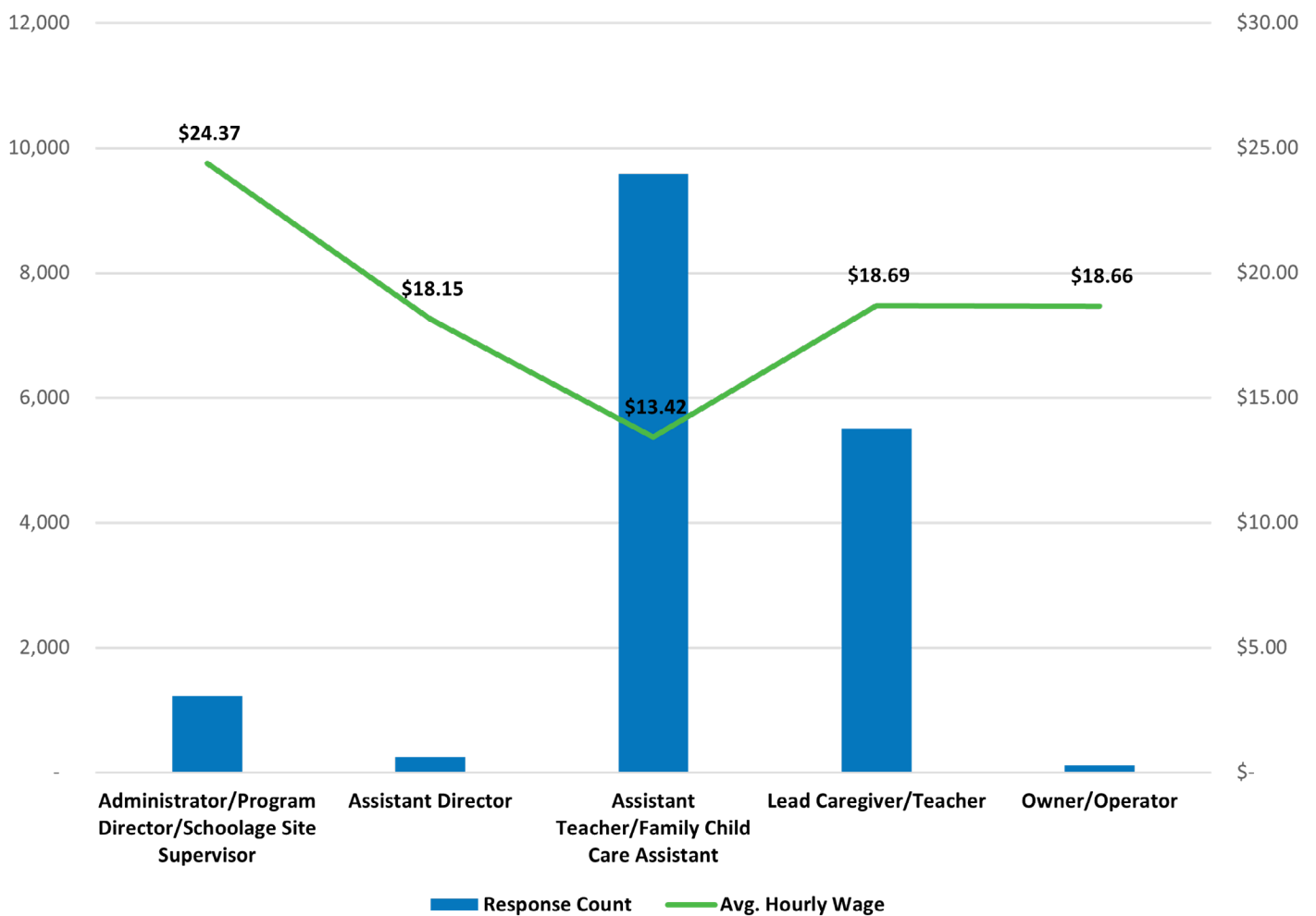

Figure 16: Verified Wage Distribution by Setting and Position Title

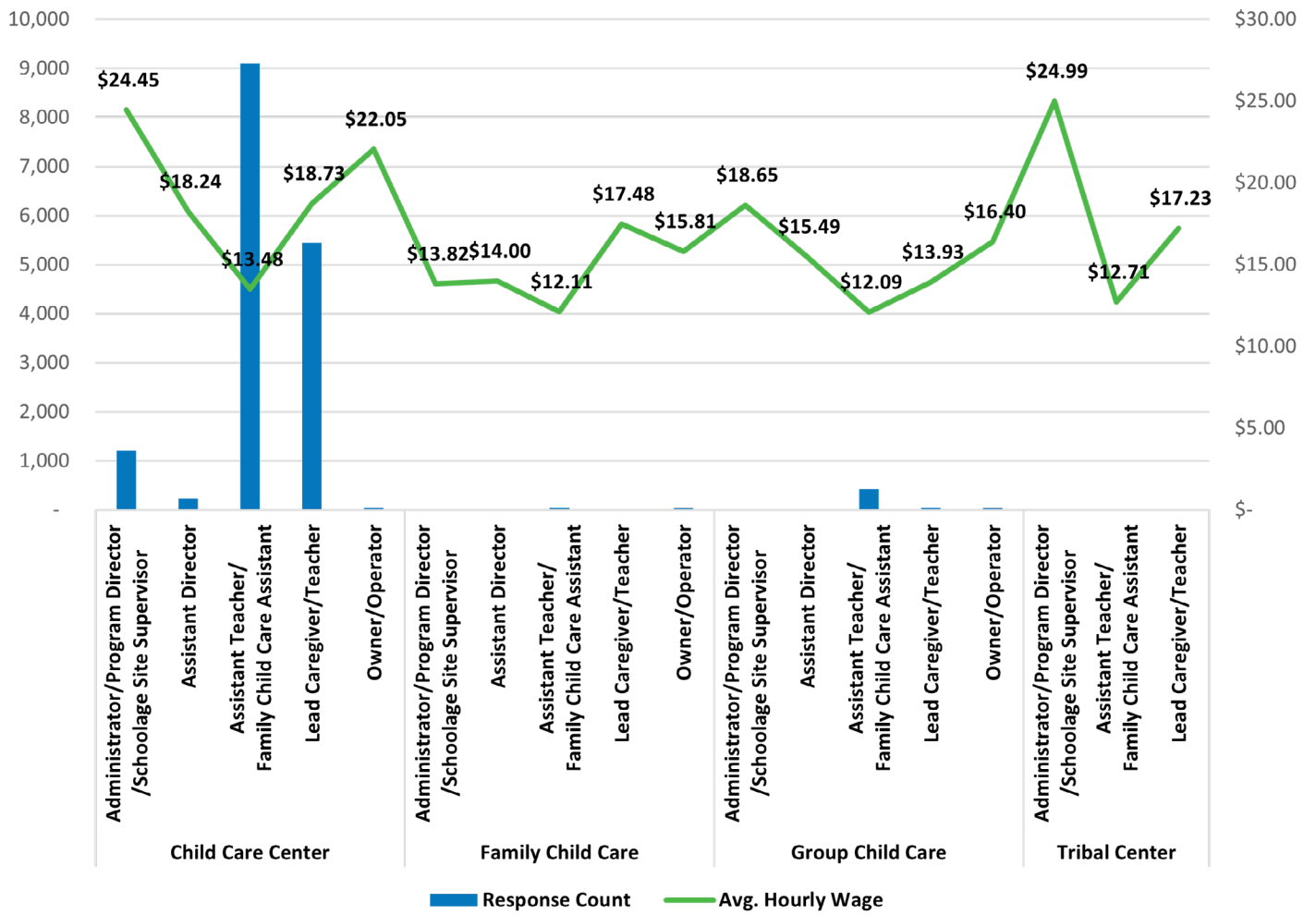

Figure 17: Verified Wage Distribution by Tenure

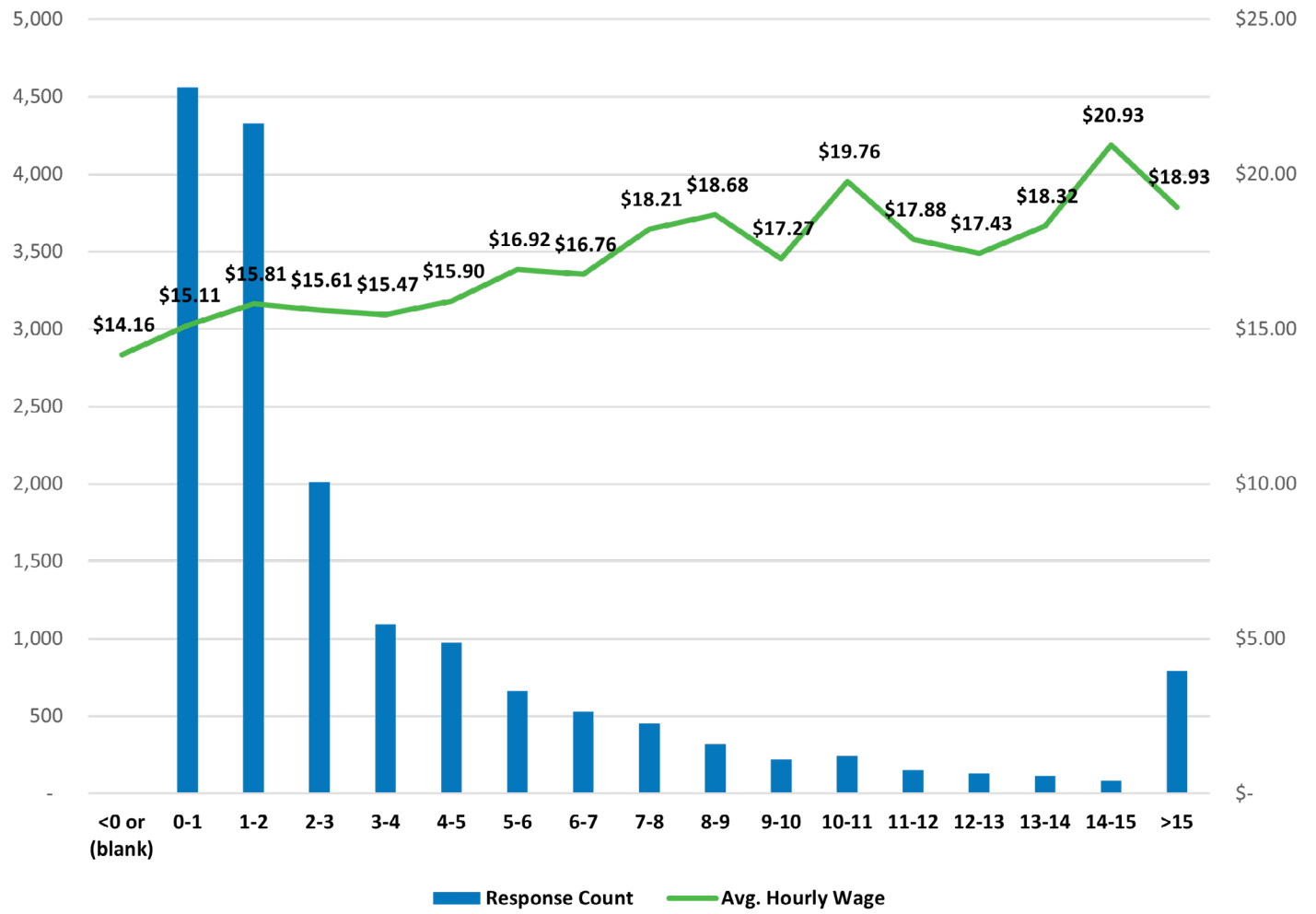

Figure 18: Verified Wage Distribution by Position Title and Tenure

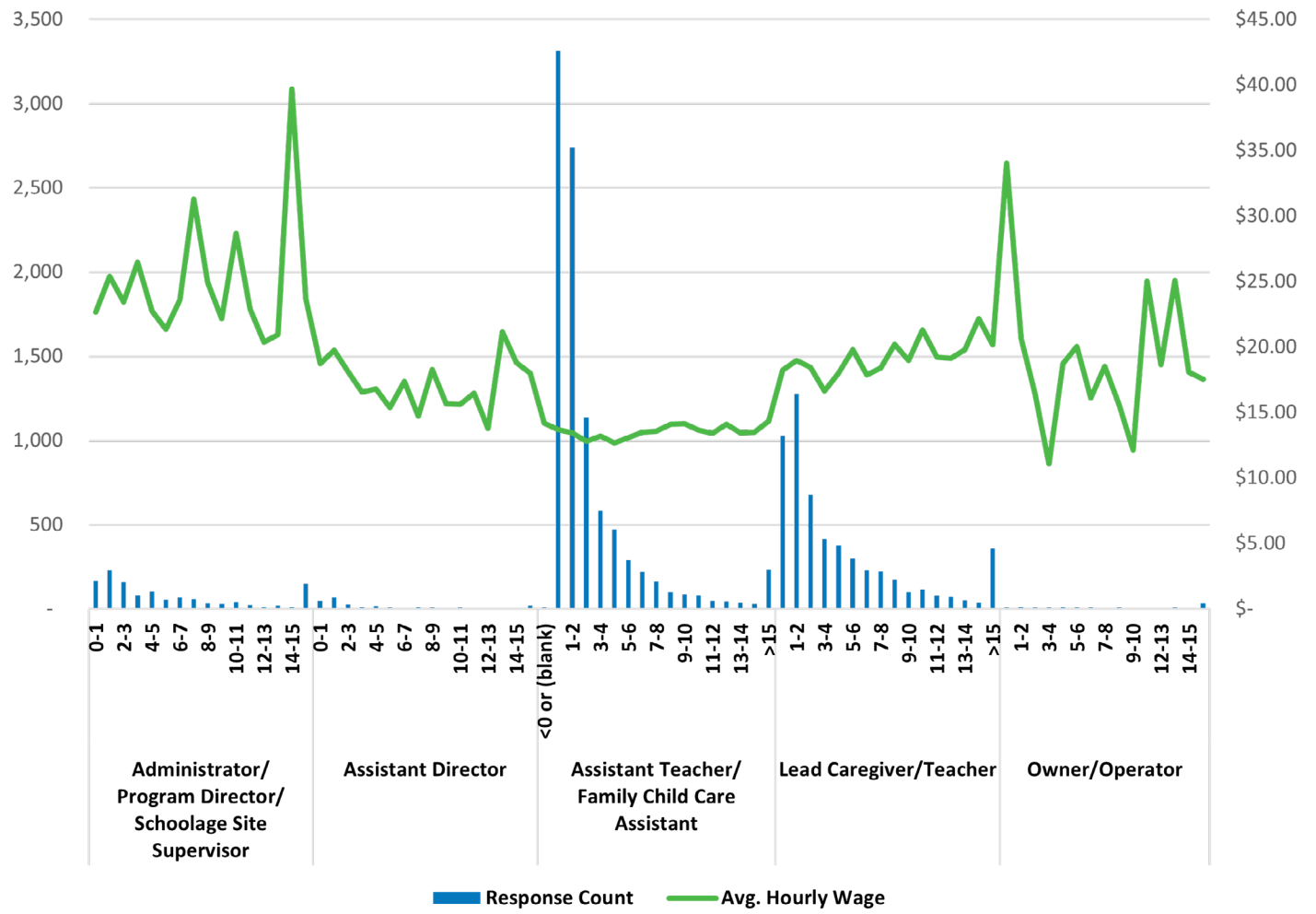
